"Riding is such a wonderful way to see and feel the surroundings," said Flanagan. "I can't ever see myself not cranking it up and hitting the road. I especially enjoy the look on people's faces when I come roaring up on my Harley with my priest collar on."

When Flanagan is not performing bike blessings, he works at Food for the Poor (FFP), a Christian international aid organization that helps the poor of the Caribbean and Central America.
